





Problems & Challenges: Clustering Case Files

- Highly Heterogeneous Content
- Multiple documents merged into single PDF
- Handwriting, Redaction, Noisy OCR

Problems & Challenges: Entity Resolution

- Different Officers have the same name, same employer, at same time
- <u>1</u> Officer \rightarrow <u>N</u> Different Cases
- On 6/17/2019: **5** different individuals named Jose Martinez interacted with LAPD
- Officers "migrate" between different Agencies



Pipeline Overview: What are we clustering Files on?

- <u>Primary Strategy</u>: Filepath and filename metadata
 - Extracting: Case ID's, Names, Dates
- <u>Secondary Strategy</u>: Extract Features from File Content (OCR):
 - Officer names
 - Subject names
 - Incident dates
 - Case identifiers
- <u>Fallback</u>: LLM Summarization of File Content (OCR)
 - Pairwise comparison between chunked file summaries via prompt

- Entity Resolution for Officers, Involved Agencies
- Automate candidate links to State Database Records
- Automate consolidation/merging of clusters ("cases")
- Document Classification (PDF document/pagerange types)
- PII, Violent Imagery Classification

- Cluster on extracted features for Multimedia File Content
- Implement HIL Agentic Framework for public records request workflow
- Supervised learning pipeline


